January 2026 (following Provisional Monitoring review)

Accreditation-Provisional; Program demonstrates continued progress in complying with the *Standards* as it prepares for the graduation of the first class of students. The commission noted 10 areas of noncompliance with the *Standards*. The program received a Warning Letter regarding institutional support for providing the program with sufficient human resources and the implementation and documentation of the program's ongoing self-assessment process.

Next Comprehensive Evaluation: January 2028 (Final Provisional). Maximum class size: 35.
