### September 2025

Accreditation-Provisional; Program demonstrates continued progress in complying with the *Standards* as it prepares for the graduation of the first class of students. The commission noted three areas of noncompliance with the *Standards*. Next Comprehensive Evaluation: September 2026 (Final Provisional). Maximum class size: 50.
