Next review: October 2035

Maximum class size: 60

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### September 2025

Accreditation-Continued; Program has demonstrated continued and sufficient compliance with the ARC-PA *Standards* after completion of the provisional review process. The commission noted 8 areas of noncompliance with the *Standards*.

Next Comprehensive Evaluation: October 2035. Maximum class size: 60.

Report due December 8, 2025 (*Standards*, 5<sup>th</sup> edition):

### March 2025

Program Change: change in credits and length of program. The commission **approved the program's proposed change**. No further information requested.

### September 2024

Program Change: Increase in credits from 103 to 108. The commission **approved the program's proposed change**. No further information requested.

### June 2024

The commission **reviewed and requested more information of the report** providing evidence of

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- Documentation from surveys and/or other resources that show data related to making the changes to the clinical year, institutional letter of approval for the curriculum changes, and data showing how the changes were discovered and determined the conclusion to increase the number of credits from 2 to 3 for the PHA 511 Human Physiology course.

Additional information (comparison of how the change in credits and length of rotations does not exceed the length of the program, letter from the administration showing approval of the increase in overall credits to the program from 103 to 108, meeting minutes and analysis for the changes being made to PHA 511 Physiology and the length of clinical rotations, information about PHA 620 versus Psychiatry and Mental Health, information on how the program added two weeks to the clinical year without extending the program length, documentation of formal approval at the institutional level of the change in credits and documentation from an institution that there is no increase in length and cost of the program, and benchmarks for qualitative and quantitative surveys). due May 28, 2024.

### September 2023

Program Change: Change in graduation requirements. The commission **reviewed and requested more information** (documentation from surveys and/or other resources that show data related to making the changes to the clinical year, institutional letter of approval for the curriculum changes, and data showing how the changes were discovered and determined the conclusion to increase the number of credits from 2 to 3 for the PHA 511 Human Physiology course) by November 15, 2023.

### June 2021

Program Change: Change in class size (one-time temporary increase from 60 to 62 students for year-one cohort), effective May 10, 2021. The commission **approved the proposed change**. No further information requested.

### March 2021

Program Change: Change in class size (50 to 60), effective August 16, 2021. The commission **approved the proposed change**. No further information requested.

### June 2020

The commission **acknowledged the report** providing evidence of

- The proposed plan in response to COVID-19. No further information requested.

### September 2015

Accreditation-Continued; Next Comprehensive Evaluation: September 2025. The program's maximum class size remains 50. The commission noted zero areas of noncompliance with the *Standards*.

### March 2012

Accreditation-Provisional; Next Comprehensive Evaluation: September 2015. The program is approved for up to 100 students. The commission noted zero areas of noncompliance with the *Standards*.
