

## SUNY Upstate Medical Center Accreditation History

First accredited: March 2009

Next review: July 2026

Maximum class size: 35

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### September 2025

The program's PANCE pass rate percentage was 85% or less for its 2024 cohort. The program submitted the required analysis of PANCE performance. The commission **reviewed and requested more information of the report**. Additional information (revised and resubmitted PANCE Required Report) due January 5, 2026.

### March 2025

Program Change: Increase maximum entering class size to 55 students. The commission **did not approve the program's proposed change**. The program is welcome to reapply.

### June 2021

The program received an alert through the Program Management Portal that the number of students exceeded the maximum entering class size. The program submitted the required Exceeding Class Size report. The commission accepted the report. No further information requested.

### June 2020

The commission **acknowledged the report** providing evidence of

- The proposed plan in response to COVID-19. No further information requested.

### March 2017

The program received an alert through the Program Management Portal that the number of students exceeded the maximum entering class size. The program submitted the required Exceeding Class Size report. The commission **accepted the report**. No further information requested.

### July 2016

Accreditation-Continued; Next Comprehensive Evaluation: September 2026. Maximum class size: 35. The commission noted zero areas of noncompliance with the *Standards*.

### March 2012

Accreditation-Continued; Next Comprehensive Evaluation: March 2015. Maximum Student Capacity: 105.
