Accreditation-Provisional; Program has not yet enrolled students but plans and resource allocation, if fully implemented as planned, demonstrated the probability to meet the ARC-PA *Standards*. The commission noted 8 areas of noncompliance with the *Standards* and 3 new commission observations. Next Comprehensive Evaluation: TBD (Provisional Monitoring). Maximum class size: 40.
